CRATE ENGINE REPAIR AND VERIFICATION PROGRAM
PROGRAM TO GO INTO EFFECT FEBRUARY 1, 2020

DIRTcar Northeast has instituted a new program for Crate Engines which includes DIRTcar Authorized Verification/Repair Facilities to conduct all repairs and engine verifications.

The Guidelines have been set by DIRTcar and all work and documentation will be overseen by Pace Performance who also handles our DIRTcar Midwest Programs.

REPAIR:

- A.) A crate engine has to have a mechanical problem that doesn't allow it to perform as GM Designed.
- B.) You will take your crate engine to one of the Authorized Centers to evaluate what needs to be repaired
- C.) The Authorized Center will then send their evaluation to Pace Performance for approval of part(s) to be fixed.
- D.) If approved the Authorized Center will make the repair at a cost sent to you and perform the work.
- E.) If Pace Performance and Authorized Center determines that the repair will cost too much you will be advised to then purchase a new crate engine.

Verification:

- A.) The verification process is to have the crate engine checked to make sure it's within all GM specifications and then sealed.
- B.) Verification will be either after a crate engine that was repaired, current crate engines being used sent to Authorized Centers to be verified or new crate engines purchased verified either by Pace or the Authorized Centers.

A new sealing process will be in effect through Pace Performance and All crate engines will need to be verified by February 2022.

NOTES:

- All crate engines currently being used are all set for competition for 2020, new bottle-capped or DIRTcar sealed.
- It is encouraged to have your crate engines verified by the Authorized Centers which will help in expediting tech at your home track(s).
- It is encouraged to get all new crate engines verified before you install in your car, saves on cost.
- Verified Crate engines can be purchased directly from Pace or Authorized Centers. You may also purchase your crate engine from your local GM dealer. Just be conscious of the verification process and costs.
- All Authorized Centers have contractual agreements through Pace to perform all processes set forth by DIRTcar and GM specifications and the legality of work.

The Authorized Verification/Repair Centers are: Enders Racing Engines, Phoenix, NY, Donath Motorworx, Syracuse, NY, Hunt's Machine, Schenectady, NY, Petrucci Engines/Carlquist Comp. Engines, Oakville Ct, Lussier Chevrolet, St-Hyacinthe, Que., LaFrance Performance, Long Sault, Ont., and New Generation Engines, Fenwick Ont.
(More Centers can be added at any time when demand allows)

Contact information for all centers as well as Pace Performance will be listed in the 2020 DIRTcar Rulebook which will be out any day.
