No Alcohol or drugs permitted in the pit area

Pit opens at 9am (9:30am on Sunday), Driver's meeting scheduled at 1pm and Scorers at 1:30pm, racing will start at 2pm

Scorers must attend the meeting 1:30pm or their car will not be scored, the meeting will be held in the grandstands near the flag stand.

Purses are:

Mens 4 cylinders: 1. \$300; 2. \$200; 3. \$100

Mens 6 cylinders: 1. \$300; 2. \$200; 3. \$100

Mens 8 cylinders: 1. \$500; 2. \$300; 3. \$100

Mens Vans: 1. \$300; 2. \$200; 3. \$100

Ladies 4 cylinders: \$300; 2. \$200; 3. \$100

Mens Trucks: 1. \$300; 2. \$200; 3. \$100

Trailer Race and Chain Race: Purse to be determined on number of cars registered.

TRAILER RACE RULES

Open to any driver and any Enduro Car, Mini Van, Small SUV, Jeep or Small Pick Up and is a 15-lap race. To be declared the winner your trailer must still be attached to your car on the 15th lap when you cross the line. If you lose your trailer prior to the end of the race you are allowed to continue racing and try to remove your competitors trailer.

Rules for the Trailer are as follows:

- **No pintle type hitches or no homemade style hitches, must be a standard ball and coupler type hitch.**
- **Ball may be attached to the trailer in any manor however cannot stick out past the rear bumper more than a standard ball would.**
- **No semi-trailers, or semi-trailer axles or tires, **no campers or boats****

Chain Race Rules and Information

Objective:

This is a team event consisting of two cars per team. The two cars are chained together with a powered "pull" car towing an unpowered "trail" car. The length of the race will be 20 laps. The goal is to complete the 20 laps with both cars still attached together.

Procedural Rules:

1. Connection of vehicles:

- a. **Cars must connect using a 3/8" link or larger steel chain mounted to chassis, NOT to bumper. A single chain must tie the two cars together centered on the rear of the pull car and front of trail car. Chain may only be attached on each car in one spot forming a single chain connection between them.**
- b. **Chain must be free standing (Not welded) no pipes allowed outside chains.**
- c. **Trailer hitch frames permitted, Fabrication of frame mount for connection of chain permitted with no connections traveling past bumper face.**
- d. **Cars must have a maximum of eight (8) feet between them when connected bumper to bumper.**
- e. **The trail car may not be under power at any point during the race. Removal of driveshaft is recommended.**
- f. **The driver of the trail car can steer and apply brakes to help with control.**
- g. **Passengers are not permitted in either car.**
- h. **If a chain breaks or cars become disconnected that team is eliminated and must exit the speedway surface.**
- i. **This is a race, not a demolition derby, so teams need to focus on reaching the checkered flag first.**

Technical Rules:**1. Eligible Cars:**

- a. Open to any 4 or 6 or 8-cylinder hardtop passenger car, minivan or truck half-ton or smaller.
- b. Pull car must operate in two-wheel drive only.

2. Body and Chassis:

- a. All glass must be removed though windshield removal is optional. If removed, a screen must be in place to protect the driver.
- b. All lights and molding must be removed.
- c. Driver's doors must be welded, chained or bolted shut. For driver protection, one (1) flat stock steel plate may be mounted tight to the body on the driver's side only. No sharp edges and must be flush mounted with the body.
- d. Sunroofs must be covered with sheet metal.

3. Safety:

- a. All cars must maintain lap belt and shoulder harness and be worn by driver at all times. Five-point racing harness is allowed and recommended.
- b. Driver must wear a SNELL approved helmet.
- c. Driver must wear work boots or racing shoes, gloves, 100% cotton long-sleeved shirts and pants. No shorts, short sleeve shirts or tank tops. A driver's suit is highly recommended.
- d. A roll cage is optional; however, it is highly recommended that cars be equipped with a rollover hoop to protect the driver. Hoop should be safely constructed of seamless 1 ½" x 1/8" wall pipe welded to right and left side frame rails behind the driver.

4. Car Numbers:

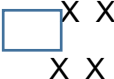
- a. Both the pull and trail cars must have the same number lettered legibly on each door. A number shark fin on the roof is recommended. Numbers will be assigned based on arrival at the speedway like our Fireball Enduro.

5. Pre-Registration:

- a. We will pre-register teams only for this race, we are planning to have a race on Saturday, September 12 and also one on September 13.
- b. Registration costs will be \$50 and money can be sent by e-transfer to Claudie@cornwallspeedway.com.
- c. All registration money is going back in the purse to the top 3: 1st = 50%, 2nd = 30% and 3rd = 20%

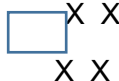

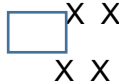

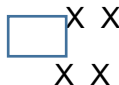

4. **No** cutting or gutting of any panels.
5. **No** bracing in front of front firewall.
6. **No** trucks, 4-wheel drives or convertibles.
7. Car must have full body.
8. Front and rear plastic bumpers must be removed. All Styrofoam packing must be removed
9. Trailer hitch allowed (original place)
10. Remove all working lights, no mirror
11. Tires allowed are the ones that come with the model of car (Winter tires are allowed)
12. Tire pressure, no less than 28 lbs. per tire.
13. **No** obscene lettering.

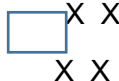

2. All glass and flammable materials must be removed
3. **No** outside reinforcement allowed.
4. Maximum 10" tires (tread width). (Winter Tires are allowed)
5. **No** cutting or gutting of any panels.
6. **No** bracing in front of front firewall.
7. **No** 4-wheel drives (must be disconnected).
8. Truck must have full stock body.
9. Trailer hitch allowed (original place)
10. Remove all working lights, no mirror
11. **No** obscene lettering.
12. Tire pressure, no less than 36 lbs. per tire.
13. **No** holes in floor @ drivers feets.
14. **No** plastic body cars.
15. SUNROOF must be closed with TIN
16. On the roof a piece of thin TIN 1 x 1 f foot with your Number on both sides, screwed from inside or rivets
