



2026 Fireball Enduro Questions and Answers:

Q: When?

A: Saturday, September 12 and Sunday, September 13, 2026

Q: Which Classes?

A: **On Sept.12** : Ladies 4 cylinders; Mens 4 cylinders, 6 cylinders, Chain Race and Open race. **On Sept.13:** 8 cyl, trucks, Vans, Chain Race, Trailer Race and we might add an open feature on Sunday depending on the number of cars left.

Q: How many laps?

A : 50 laps per feature race, some classes might have more than 1 feature depending on amount of registered car, Trailer Race will be 15 laps and Chain Race will be 20 laps.

Q : How to register?

A : At the gate on the day that your class is racing, parking for cars will be near the 401 (see photo on our Facebook page) Only for the Chain Race, we will accept pre-registration by contact Claudie at claudie@cornwallspeedway.com

Q : Registration Cost?

A : It is 50\$ per car, this does not include any admission fees for crew, payment will be accepted only on the day of the event, and it is CASH ONLY

Q : How numbers will be assigned?

A : Car numbers will be assigned by an official when your registration is confirmed at the pit gate, it is a first come first serve basis, cars will be parked on the road near the 401 in order of arrival and will be assigned this way (see photo on Facebook)

Q : Can I arrive early with my car or cars?

A : We will not accept cars on the facility until the day of your event, if you are running 4 cylinders, you must arrive on Saturday, if your class is scheduled on Sunday, you must arrive on Sunday. **We will monitor the arrivals, if you do not respect the instructions, you will be penalized.**

Q : Is Camping allowed?

A : We will allow camping **ONLY ON Saturday evening**, in the main parking, Cornwall Motor Speedway management reserves the right to ask people to leave if some are disturbing neighbours

Q : At what time the pit gate opens and racing starts?

A : We are planning to open the pit gates at 9am on Saturday and 9:30am on Sunday, meeting for drivers (near the pit tower) will be at 1pm and scorers (in the grandstand) at 1:20pm and racing will start at 2pm

Q : Admission Fees?

A : General admission is \$20 for adults, 5\$ for kids 6-16 and free for kids 0-5 and pit admission is \$25

Q : Can I purchase tickets as a spectator?

A : Tickets will be available to purchase at the gate on the day of the event, we recommend you arrive early, there is usually a lineup that forms 30-45 minutes prior the start of the event.
